"To all Americans and their allies. The war is over
and peace will be officially signed on Sept 2nd 45
aboard the battleship "Missouri" in Tokyo Bay.
Our forces will land near Tokyo tomorrow 29th/45
and a peace will be effected as soon afterward
as possible. God keep you all until then.
We three would feel deeply indebted to you
if you would sometime write to us at the
following addresses to tell us if the supplies
helped any. Its the best we could do with
limited supplies on board
